Dear OHA Member,

The Oakmore Homes Association Public Safety Committee has submitted a proposal to consider the implementation of automated license plate reader (ALPR) cameras in our neighborhood.

The proposal forms the Security Camera Program LLC (SCP), an independent entity comprised of members from the three Oakmore private patrol groups and the OHA, to raise funds for and to manage the program. It would also be empowered to interface with a camera provider and monitor ongoing camera data requests. We are pleased to inform you that the proposal was unanimously approved by the OHA Board.

While the installation of ALPR cameras is not a panacea to deterring crime, ALPR along with the OPD, our private patrols, private property camera images and your alert vigilance, it furnishes another layer of surveillance which may lead to arrests and the reduction of future crimes. We have already received a high level of interest and with your support the SCP program will allow us to become more proactive at enhancing public safety in Oakmore. **Please review a copy of the SCP LLC proposal included within this mailing.**

The OPD is launching a new survey to receive feedback on public safety and trust from our community. The survey is short and just takes a few minutes to fill out. I encourage you to do so. See the link below:
