



Membership List Contact Information, Membership List Access, and Opt-In/Opt-Out Effective October 2, 2025

In compliance with California Civil Codes, the Oakmore Homes Association (OHA) requests that members review the information below, then complete all sections of the the attached form as follows:

- Provide updated contact information for the OHA Membership List annually
- Indicate preferred and alternative methods of receiving notices from the OHA
- Decide whether to Opt-In or Opt-Out of disclosing your contact information to other OHA members

MEMBERSHIP LIST CONTACT INFORMATION: All members (property owners) are required by law to provide the Oakmore Homes Association (OHA) with **annual updates** of the **member's contact information** which includes the member's name(s), property address, preferred method of contact such as current mailing address and/or email addresses, and an alternative method of delivery of notices. (Civil Code section 4041). We prefer that you list your email addresses as the preferred method, but that is not required.

MEMBERSHIP LIST ACCESS: OHA Members do have the right to view the Membership List, including other member's contact information, but only if the purpose is related to their interest as a member. If you want to see the membership list, you must state the purpose for the request in writing to the OHA. The purpose must be reasonably related to your interest as a member. In other words, *you cannot use the membership list for other community purposes, or to advertise events, services or products, including for non-profits.*

PROPERTY STATUS: Members must inform the OHA of the **status of the property** such as whether it is owner occupied, rented or vacant. **Note:** The member/property owner is responsible for notifying tenants of information from the OHA pertinent to all residents inhabiting the property.

DISCLOSURE OF CONTACT INFORMATION - OPT-OUT or OPT-IN:

(NOTE: Please select one option. If do not select an option the default will be OPT-OUT.)

If you *do not want* your contact information to be disclosed to other members, you may select "Opt-Out" on the attached form. (Civil Code Section 5220). The OHA will forward correspondence from other members to you, as an alternative procedure. (Section 8330, Corporations Code subdivision (c)).

If you *do not object* to having your contact information disclosed to other members upon appropriate written request, you may select "Do Not Opt-Out/Opt-In" on the attached form.
